



## **Oral Scientific Paper Presentation**

#### Rules

1. Prior Registration is mandatory for scientific presentations.

2. Membership to the IPS & any state or zonal branches is mandatory.

3. Those pursuing post graduation in Karnataka, IPS, IPSSZB and IPSKC membership is mandatory.

4. Those who have applied and not yet received confirmation have to produce valid document of applying for memberships of above societies.

5. If not a member, we will help in applying for memberships to the societies, for which contact the below mentioned before 31/01/2025: Dr Somshekhar Bijjal: 9448333173

6. Along with the paper, the student has to enclose the pdf copy of bonafied certificate from the department/institute head.

7. Abstract of the scientific paper (250 words) has to be submitted before 9 pm of 10/02/2025 to the ipskcpgcme2025@gmail.com along with the details of the presenters like, name, mobile, e mail id, institute and registration details.

8. Original research work will be considered for oral presentations. The abstract shall be in the following format: Title, Background/Introduction, Methodology, Results & Conclusions.

 9. Abstracts previously presented or published in any format either in any state/zonal/national/international CME/Conferences / journals are not permitted.
 10. The scientific committee will review the abstract and acceptance will be communicated 5 days prior to the CME.

11. The right of selection of abstract lies with the scientific committee and it has right to reject without providing any intimations/reasons.

12. The accepted papers need to be sent by mail in PPT format (maximum 10 slides) 2 days before the CME, save the file in ppt format with title, your name, PGCME 2025 without any special characteristics with a size of less than 5mb.

13. The student need to carry the same in a pen drive also on the day of presentation.

14. The PPT must be with light background with dark and readable fonts (more than 20 size either with Ariel, Calibri or Times New Roman) with minimum animations.

- 15. Avoid animated images, videos or hyperlinks in the slides.
- 16. Use good quality images with more than 200 dpi resolutions.
- 17. Tables need to be created rather than pasting them as images.
- 18. Time allotted for oral presentation is 6 minutes and 2 minutes for discussions.

19. All presentations will get participation certificates and the best 3 papers will be honored with certificates and prize.

12. The accepted e-posters need to be created one page image (jpj/png) and one slide ppt. 13. The PPT/image must be with readable font and contrast background (more than 12 size either with Ariel, Calibri or Times New Roman).

14. Orientation has to be land scape layout with size of 16\*9 for your slide in power point.

15. Avoid animated images, videos or hyperlinks in the slides.

16. Use good quality images with more than 200 dpi resolutions.

17. Tables /graphs need to be created rather than pasting them as images.

18. Use the e-poster template which has been provided in the IPSKC website https://ipskc.com/

19. The e-poster need to be sent by mail in PPT format (single slides) and jpj image file 2 days before the CME, save the file with title, your name, PGCME 2025 without any special characteristics with a size of less than 5mb.

20. The student need to carry the same in a pen drive also on the day of presentation.

21. Time allotted for e-poster presentation is 4 minutes and 2 minutes for discussions.

22. All presentations will get participation certificates and the best 3 posters will be honored with certificates and prize.

## **Sahyadri Silver Jubilee KANCIPS Psychiatry PG Quiz Programme -2025**

#### Rules

16. Top 6 teams who will qualify in prelimanary round will go to final round, in case of tie, those who have made less negatives and if again tie occurs those in higher years of PG will be selected.

17. The final round will have 6 rounds including rapid fire. Rules and other details will be intimated earlier.
